Spoke to our group on the 10th. Her powerful story as director of National Alliance for Mental Illness became a very

personal story. She sensed as early as High School, that she had feelings that were not 'normal'. In college she got seen professionally and ultimately was diagnosed and treated for bi-polar.

College and alcohol were more early signs of problems. She tried to tell of the many levels of mental illness and how we need to recognize and get treatment early, if we expect success. Courtney found after her diagnosis, that there were other cases in her family tree.

NAMI attempts to build a 'support' system, not professional treatment. Some stages of the illness are Acute—Urgent—Intensive—
Maintenance—Recovery. The ER is for Emergency care only. Rochester has good facilities for further care.

New Naval Ship female quarters regulations

Department of the Navy is now assigning females to quarters in a separate private "OFF LIMITS" area

on all aircraft carriers.
